Our March Intercontinental Think Tank will be a very special meeting as Zonta Says NOW will be presenting online as part of the NGO CSW/NY 68 Forum.

[Register](#) for our two-hour Zonta Says NOW session that takes place on **Sunday 17 March from 10.30 pm to 12.30 am UTC** (6.30 pm to 8.30 pm New York time)

Did you see the latest report from the FAO entitled [The Unjust Climate](#)? It points out that an estimated one degree Celsius increase in long-term average temperatures reduces the average income of female-headed households by 34 per cent compared to that of male-headed households.

It is no wonder that the [Zonta International Statement on Climate Change](#) recommends advocating for women's full participation in the economy. Women generally find it harder to 'bounce back' economically after a disaster as they have fewer resources and opportunities than men.

The Zonta Says NOW session will explore how gender-equal climate action works to end poverty. We will show how the current economic system does not work for women and suggest some alternative models that could enable women to participate fully in the economy - including 'doughnut economics'. With discussion groups, polls and videos this will be an engaging session.

February Meeting

In February, we celebrated the World Day of Social Justice.

We heard from two speakers:

- **Mwanahamisi Singano (Mishy)**, who is the Program Manager, Global Policy from the Women's Environment and Development Organization (WEDO). Mishy described the work of WEDO and shared her experiences from COP 28. WEDO is a global women's rights advocacy organization working to promote a just world, protect human rights, advance gender equality and ensure there is environmental integrity.
- **Nomena Rasoamanandraibe**, who is the President of the Zonta Club of Madagascar. Nomena and her club members had been out on the streets of Andravoahangy and in the countryside interviewing people and taking photos of people in markets, health centres and harvesting fields. She captured life in Madagascar and shared some of the challenges caused by

flooded streets, plastic blocking drainage channels and air pollution associated with vehicles.
